

# Fort Campbell Army Installation Access Control Procedures

Escorted Visitors with a valid photo ID (state driver's license, passport) traveling in the same Vehicle as a DoD ID card holder (CAC, dependent ID Card, Retiree ID card are not required to obtain a pass.

Unescorted Visitors who are not traveling in the same vehicle as a DoD ID card holder (CEC. Dependent ID card. Retiree ID card must obtain a visitor's passfrom a Visitors. Control Center for the duration of their visit. You must show proof of vehicle insurance & registration.

# Visitor Control Center Hours of Operation:

Gate Passes can be obtained at Gates 7 & 4 from 5:00 am to 9:00 pm Gates 7 & 4 are open 7 days per week, 24 hours per day
